







# Setup OpenLP “Library”


Overhead Projector Screen



# Starting OpenLP

Type “openlp” in the Windows Search on the Taskbar and press **Enter** key to open the OpenLP Application.

Open start “OpenLP” from Utilities folder from your PortableApps SDCX card.

# Adding a New Song with Audio

Search the Internet to find the Lyrics of the new song and paste the song into Notepad or print and type in the new song. With a license to CCLI you can import the lyrics of many songs using “File, Import, CCLI SongSelect” directly into the Song database.


Public Domain Music info can be found at <https://helensedwick.com/sources-of-public-domain-lyrics/> Press “F1” and go to “Songs, Song Importer” for more info.

Search the Internet to find a free “Instrumental audio” of your choice and download the mp3 audio file to link to the new song.

Once you have this information, you can create a new song in OpenLP. Start by clicking the new song icon to open the “Song Editor” and begin.

**OR** you can simply select a Song from the OpenLP Library and drag and drop your desired song to the Service window at far right.

# Adding New Bible Versions


You can File, Import, Bible for more versions.

Many other Bible versions can be downloaded  
Please be sure to paste copyright permission for any Bible versions that are not Public Domain!  
Press “F1” key and go to “Bibles” for more information on add different Bible versions for many other sources.

Note: Your PC must have “WWW internet” access for OpenLP to ADD new verses from the “Web” during Service! However, once saved in a Service file internet access is not required when reopening the and running a saved Service file.

Without “Wifi” access: you can “cut-and-paste” verses for any Bible version using “Custom Slides” in the “Library” for display during a service.

Press “F1” and go to “Library, Bibles” or “Custom Slides” for more info.





# Adding Sermon Presentations

“Presentations” can be displayed in many formats:  
(pdf,xps,oxps,epub,cbz,fb2,odp,ppt,pps,pptx,ppsx,pptm)


Adobe® format: pdf (recommended format)

e-Book format: epub

LibreOffice/OpenOffice Impress format: odp

Microsoft® Power Point formats: ppt, pptx, pptm

Other Church Presentation software, like ProPresenter®, works best with jpg files (1920x1080 pixels) for each overhead file. These files can be simply made with LibreOffice/OpenOffice Impress and exported. Then the jpg files in Images can be loaded as a group and be renamed as an item in the Service to work the same as ProPresenter®.






# Adding Images & Loops

“Images” can be displayed in many formats:  
(bmp,cur,gif,icns,ico,jpeg,jpg,pbm,pgm,png,ppm,  
svg,svgz,tga,tif,tiff,wbmp,webp,xbm,xpm)

Recommended image formats jpg, png, & gif are suggested.

Images are saved in “Group” folders. Each “Group” folder can be moved to the Service and set to automatically play a single or continuous loops with adjustable timing between images in seconds.

Widescreen (1920x1080 pixel) “GoodBye, Misc, Motion Background, Scripture and Welcome” images are available for free from AOG.





# Adding Media or Videos

“Videos” and “Audio” files can be displayed in many formats, using the new “built-in VLC code”:


